

What is NREN?

A National Research and Education Network is both;

- a high performance communications network owned and operated for and by the education and research community of a country (e.g SomaliREN) and;
- 2) the organization that operates that network, constituted as a consortium of members

National research and education networks (NRENs) play a critical role in the development of communication network infrastructure and networked services for researchers and educators.



A Bit About SomaliREN


- SomaliREN is a membership based organization started and owned by its member institutions which are 24 members strong.

 - ASREN








Higher Education Services: Connectivity


Internet connectivity is the primary form of intervention to enable easy collaboration among education and research institutions.






HE Services: Digital Repositories

 The purpose of eduVPN is to provide a more secure access to public and private networks for the international research and education community.



- Integration with eduGAIN/ LDAP



HE Services: File Sharing, Event& Survey Tools

File Sender

- Send large files securely and encrypted
- A fully transparent open source filesending web application
- Developed to the requirements of the higher education and research community
- Not intended as a permanent file publishing platform

Event Management

- Manage Events of different complexity
- Full conference lifecycle
- Hierarchical Protection
 Scheme
- Room Booking Module
- Integration with Collaborative Tools
- Open-source tool for event organization, archival and collaboration

Survey Tool

- Unlimited number of surveys at the same time
- Unlimited number of questions in a survey
- Unlimited number of participants to a survey
- Integration of pictures and movies into a survey
- Data Export Excel, CSV, SPSS, Word, PDF
- Conditions for questions depending on earlier answers (Skip Logic / Branching)
